ORDER
GRANTING RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On March 11, 2026, Sylvester Thomas filed a Formal Complaint against FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Mr. Thomas alleged that there were incorrect charges on his bill, that he would like a payment arrangement, and that he was having a reliability, safety, or quality problem with his utility service.

On April 1, 2026, FE PA filed an Answer to the Complaint, admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.¹

The Commission scheduled this matter for an evidentiary hearing on May 22, 2026.

On May 7, 2026, FE PA filed its Motion of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company for Continuance of Hearing. FE PA sought continuance of the evidentiary hearing due to the unavailability of its primary witness on the hearing date. FE PA indicated Mr. Thomas was agreeable to a continuance of the hearing.

¹ FE PA in its Answer asserted that service at the service address is in the name of I am Home Care, LLC. Corporations are required to be represented by an attorney in adversarial proceedings before the Commission. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 1.21(b). At the evidentiary hearing in this matter, I am Home Care, LLC, would be required to be represented by an attorney.
