FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero dated April 8, 2026, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That PGW late-filed Exhibit 5 is admitted into the record.

2. That the Formal Complaint of Munira Edens-McClean in Munira Edens-McClean v. Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket No. C-2025-3056797 is granted, in part, and denied, in part.

3. That the Formal Complaint is denied as to Munira Edens-McClean’s claim that Philadelphia Gas Works improperly discontinued a payment arrangement when she changed her service address.

4. That the Complaint is granted as to Munira Edens-McClean's request for a payment arrangement.


5. That Munira Edens-McClean shall make monthly payments consisting of her current charges or budget bill, plus one sixth (1/6th) of the balance accrued on her account, beginning with the first billing due date following the entry of a final Commission Order in this case.

6. That, as long as Munira Edens-McClean adheres to the terms of this Order, Philadelphia Gas Works shall not assess any late payment charges nor shall Philadelphia Gas Works terminate service to Munira Edens-McClean, except for valid safety and/or emergency reasons.

7. That if Munira Edens-McClean fails to keep the payment schedule, Philadelphia Gas Works is authorized to suspend or terminate her utility service in accordance with the Commission's statute and regulations.

8. That the Secretary's Bureau mark this matter closed.
