Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

1.) You have mixed up multiple different service type applications' questions. Please e-file a completely new Paratransit service application which incorporates the following corrections and information requests. This should be filed under Docket # A-2026-3062311. Also, reference this docket # on the new application.

2.) Question #10 of the application. The territory description is not acceptable. The PUC is specifically interested in the counties from which operations will originate. Please revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend. Please make corrections with the Commission's criteria in mind or verify that the example below is what you now intend.

Example: To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Paratransit service, from points in the Allegheny County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

Note: Please reference the attached list of territory/service templates on the last pages of this data request for proper verbiage.

FYI: Luggage not accompanied by the owner/rider will need a property application in addition.

3.) Question # 2 of the Verified Statement. The answer was omitted. We need you to list MJM Luxury Ridez LLC's relationship with other Motor Carrier companies here.

2. Question #5 of the Verified Statement requires that you describe your hiring and employment policies. In case of expansion, the Commission will not re-evaluate your hiring standards and your knowledge of the applicable laws. You must provide these answers within your initial application. Provide compliant code specific policies that satisfies the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to specific chapters. Please review Title 52 online at www.pacode.com.

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. Will drivers have to be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) § 29.504. Driver History. How often will a driver license check be done?

C.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will a record check be done and what are the disqualifications of employment?

D.) § 29.506. Controlled substance prohibition. and § 29.507. Controlled substance prohibition. What are your policies about alcohol and drug use by your drivers?

E.) Finally, explain your policy regarding your driver training program beyond saying that only one will be offered and completed.

4.) Question #6 of the Verified Statement has not been answered. Please provide make, model, seating capacity, and mileage for ALL the company's vehicles presented on the balance sheet.

5.) Financial Position.

A.) **Please verify** that all assets and debts listed in the submitted (Balance Sheet) are held by the applicant (**MJM Luxury Ridez LLC**), and not the member(s). Any property listed **MUST** be held to the corporation which is applying for authority. In your Balance Sheet submission, you provided information which states the LLC owns land/building(s) and is paying a mortgage. We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling its assets/debts, which is not permissible.

B.) If you have erroneously comingled the applicant's corporate assets/debts with those of the corporate member's personal assets/debts, then a revised Balance Sheet is required. The information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available.

C.) If your previously submitted Balance Sheet is accurate, please submit a statement indicating such, including proof of ownership such as copies of registrations and titles all in the name of MJM Luxury Ridez LLC.

D.) To be clear, MJM Luxury Ridez LLC has a commercial loan in the amount of \$18,000 due within one year?

E.) At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Provide supporting documentation to verify the reported cash assets of \$5,000. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of MJM Luxury Ridez LLC (account numbers may be redacted).

- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses

PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:

The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by our company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties. Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.

Examples below:

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited to a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

- a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and
- b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason
