Dear Joseph Bonamico:

By the Commission's Order entered October 23, 2025, at Docket No. M-2025-3042412 (October 2025 Order), the Commission approved the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement between the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (BIE) and Pocono Waterworks Company, Inc. (Pocono). Additionally, by Ordering Paragraph 2 of the October 2025 Order, the Commission directed Pocono to provide the data gathered from meter testing and/or replacement (Meter Testing and Replacement Data) with the Commission, consistent with the following:

“That, in accordance with Paragraph 36 of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement, Pocono Waterworks Company, Inc. shall provide the data gathered from the meter testing and/or replacement to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services every six months for a period of seven years so that the Commission may monitor compliance with Chapter 65 of the Commission's Regulations.”

The October 2025 Order was entered on October 23, 2025. Accordingly, Pocono's Meter Testing and Replacement Data was to be filed with the Commission by April 23, 2026. As of the date of this Secretarial Letter, Pocono has not filed with the Commission its Meter Testing and Replacement Data. Pocono is advised that failure to file with the Commission a complete, substantive Meter Testing and Replacement Data within ten (10) business days of the date of this Secretarial Letter may result in the referral of this matter to BIE for such further action as BIE may deem warranted.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
