THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Philadelphia Gas Works Exhibits one through seven are admitted into the record of this proceeding.
2. That the Complaint of JeVaughn Daley against Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket No. C-2025-3059190 is denied in part and granted in part.
3. That the Complaint is denied in that the Complainant is not eligible for a second or subsequent Commission-issued payment arrangement or to an extension of his previous payment arrangement under the terms of Chapter 14.

4. That the Complaint is granted in that the Complainant is eligible for restoration of his gas service pursuant to the terms of 52 Pa. Code § 56.191(c)(2)(iii).

5. That PGW may charge a fee to restore the Complainant's gas service pursuant to 52 Pa.Code § 56.191(c)(2)(iii).

6. That upon entry of a Commission Final Order in this matter, Docket C-2025-3059190 be marked closed.
