1.) Question # 2 Verified Statement of Applicant.

Is there a sharing of assets and/or facilities between North Carolina, Georgia and Pennsylvania (PA)? If so, is there financial compensation from PA to those companies?

Simple Relocations LLC does not share assets or facilities between North Carolina, Georgia, and Pennsylvania. There is no co-mingling of equipment, personnel, or financial activity between Pennsylvania operations and any affiliated entities in North Carolina or Georgia. No financial compensation is exchanged between Pennsylvania these operations.

Simple Relocations LLC is properly registered in Pennsylvania and maintains a physical business location within the Commonwealth. The company also maintains a nearby operational support location in Delaware (approximately 15 minutes from Pennsylvania), used for logistical efficiency.

2.) Question # 3 of the Verified Statement.

A.) Please provide verifiable documentation of the previous experience mentioned.

- Matthew Raley, co-owner of Simple Relocations and owner of All Ways Moving (North Carolina), has been active in the moving industry since 2009.
- Jeremy Austin Warnock, co-owner, operates a large-scale moving company in Georgia with multiple locations, a 25,000 sq ft warehouse, approximately 12 trucks, and 300 storage vaults.

B.) Who will be the Pennsylvania Managing the staff and what is their individual experience?

Jeremy Austin Warnock will serve as the primary manager responsible for Pennsylvania operations and will act as the main point of contact for the Commission. Mr. Warnock is located in close proximity to the Pennsylvania service area and will oversee:

- Daily operations and dispatch
 - Staff supervision and training
 - Regulatory compliance
 - Customer service and operational performance
- Household goods applicants are required to establish that they have the technical ability to provide the proposed service safely and legally.

3.) Question # 4 of the Verified Statement.

A.) Please respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

Vehicles will be parked at the Pennsylvania business location, which has adequate space. A nearby Delaware facility (1600 East Newport Pike, Suite C, Wilmington, DE) may also be used for staging.

B.) What are the plans for storing a shipper's goods, if the move cannot be completed in one day?

In the event that a move cannot be completed within a single day, customers' household goods will be transported to and securely stored at this facility until delivery can be completed.

Simple Relocations LLC operates a 4,000 sq ft climate-controlled facility at:
1600 East Newport Pike, Suite C
Wilmington, Delaware

Its proximity to the Pennsylvania service area allows for efficient continuation of service while ensuring the protection of customers' property.

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a required plan for drivers that fully demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.11 - Age restrictions (minimum age).

All drivers must be at least 21 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.

B.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 – Review of driver record. (schedule).

Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) checks are mandatory and conducted prior to hire by our insurance carrier. All drivers must also be approved by the company's insurance provider prior to operating company vehicles. MVR reports are performed annually to re-approve employees as drivers.

C.) 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history. (frequency of record check, disqualification of employment, and record retention).

Background checks are conducted prior to employment. Individuals with disqualifying criminal history may not be eligible for employment. Records are maintained in the office in accordance with company policy and state regulations.

D.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR part 391.27 relating to training program.

What are the criteria for successful completion of training? How long is probationary period? Attach the structured training program mentioned, with these answers.

All employees are required to complete:

- ProMover University training
- Employee Handbook acknowledgment
- Operational system training, including Samsara ELD and SmartMoving CRM

All prospective drivers must complete a ride-along evaluation conducted by Jeremy Austin Warnock to assess competency and safety prior to approval. Employees are subject to a 30-day probationary period, during which performance and adherence to company policies are evaluated. Only employees who successfully complete training and probation are permitted to operate independently.

E.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 382 relating to controlled substances and alcohol

use testing. Please give the names of companies you are considering for conducting drug/alcohol preemployment, post-accident, and random tests. What are the consequences for your driver(s) if they do not comply?

Simple Relocations LLC maintains a drug-free workplace policy, including:

- Reasonable suspicion testing
- Random drug testing

The company intends to utilize qualified third-party providers such as Arcpoint Labs of Wilmington and Fastest Labs of Springfield for drug and alcohol testing services. Failure to comply with testing requirements or company policy will result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

This is a startup so once we get authority to operate in PA we will increase our truck count. We do have about \$8,000 worth of moving supplies we ordered recently to have on hand. Roughly \$53,000 in our bank account. Attached is our official bank balance from WSFS Bank.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service.

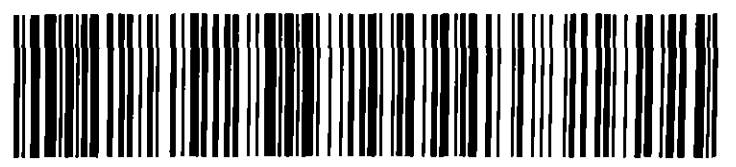

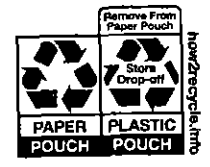
