

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“NFGDC”) is aware Meter Energy Technologies, LLC (MET) has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas service to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the service territory of NFGDC.

As you know, in making such an application, MET must furnish acceptable security to each utility where MET will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require MET to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC’s understanding that MET intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, MET will never take title to any delivered natural gas, nor will it accept any customer payments or deposits.

Based upon your representations, NFGDC has determined that, at this time, MET does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. However, if the services provided by MET change in the future, NFGDC reserves the right to require security from MET as it deems appropriate.

Re: Bonding Requirements

Dear Mikel Cammisa:

PECO is aware that Meter Energy Technologies, LLC has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application Meter Energy Technologies, LLC could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. Meter Energy Technologies, LLC has indicated that it intends to provide only brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers; will not take title to any delivered natural gas; nor will accept any customer payments or deposits.

Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that Meter Energy Technologies, LLC does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by Meter Energy Technologies, LLC, or the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Meter Energy Technologies, LLC to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.
