I am writing on behalf of Kern Trucking LLC in response to the tentative order dated April 21, 2026 regarding the proposed cancellation of our Certificate of Public Convenience due to reporting zero revenue for multiple consecutive years.

My business is actively engaged in operations and does generate revenue. However, all transportation services performed consist of hauling logs (forestry products) from harvesting sites to sawmills. These activities fall within the exemptions from the PUC.

Each year, I file my annual report by reporting the total amount and entering 0 as the exempt amount.

I am a carrier that remains active and in good standing and wishes to retain its Certificate of Public Convenience for potential future use involving regulated operations.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the proposed cancellation be withdrawn.
