Dear Secretary Homsher,

I have received your tentative order for cancellation of certificates of public convenience. I do understand that we did not show any income for the last two years of service. Our initial reasoning for applying for the PUC license, as it was required by the Office Of Long Term Living for reimbursement for waiver programs. Since these programs have been taken over by Manage Care Organizations, it has been a process to try and continue services at this time. Although we still provide services to these waiver participants we are unable to bill for those services. I have been assured by at least two of the MCO's that the services will be reinstated in the future. I believe that is essential for us to continue to be listed as a transportation provider with a PUC license in order to continue the services once these billing issues are resolved. I therefore request that Family Matters Home Care continues as a active PUC license holder.

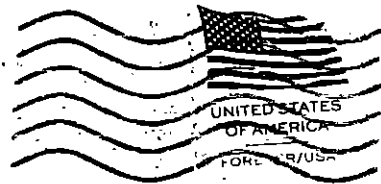
