Honorable Commissioner Homsher:

Michael B. Stoner, Inc. ("the Company"), Utility Code 8922010, respectfully submits this Comment to the Tentative Order issued April 16, 2026 and posted April 22, 2026 under Docket M-2026-3061024, proposing cancellation of the Company's Certificate of Public Convenience in Docket A-2019-3008820.

THE COMPANY TIMELY FILED ITS 2025 ASSESSMENT REPORT

The Company submitted its 2025 Motor Carrier Assessment Report on February 24, 2026 at 3:35 PM through the Commission's online filing portal. The filing included all required financial information and supporting documentation.

THE COMPANY REPORTED \$663,541 IN PENNSYLVANIA INTRASTATE OPERATING REVENUE

As reflected in the filed report:

PA Exempt Intrastate Revenue: \$663,541

Category: Waste, Excavated and Road Construction Materials

PA Net Intrastate Operating Revenue: \$0

This revenue was properly classified as exempt under the Commission's rules governing construction-related materials.

THE \$0 NET REVENUE IS CORRECT AND CONSISTENT WITH PUC INSTRUCTIONS

Because all intrastate revenue earned by the Company falls within the exempt construction-materials category, the Company's net intrastate operating revenue is correctly reported as \$0. This does not indicate a failure to report revenue; it reflects the exemption structure established by the Commission.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION WAS INCLUDED

The Company uploaded the required supporting file ("ar-25 support.pdf") as part of the online submission.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP IF AUTHORITY IS CANCELLED

Cancellation of the Company's Certificate of Public Convenience would cause immediate and significant financial hardship, including:

- Loss of hauling work from major contractors requiring an active PUC number
- Inability to perform for-hire intrastate hauling, a core part of the Company's operations
- Violation of insurance requirements mandating active PUC authority while hauling for others
- Loss of revenue, disruption of scheduled projects, and potential layoffs

The Company's business model depends on maintaining active PUC authority, and cancellation would jeopardize its ability to operate.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

For the reasons stated above, Michael B. Stoner, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission:

1. Withdraw the proposed cancellation contained in the Tentative Order (M-2026-3061024);
2. Affirm the Company's Certificate of Public Convenience as active in Docket A-2019-3008820;
3. Acknowledge the Company's exempt revenue classification as compliant; and
4. Close the docket, as the Company is in full compliance with all reporting obligations.
