To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3062106 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

On April 29, 2026, the applicant was issued a 10-day data request in response to its April 28, 2026, application for authority. The data request outlined multiple issues and provided guidance and examples to assist the applicant in preparing its response. Areas of particular concern for the Commission were the applicant's intended authority type, its hiring/retention policies, and its equipment/financial fitness.

On May 12, 2026, the Commission received the applicant's response. While the applicant provided acceptable responses concerning its proposed manner of operations and minimum driver's age; the applicant failed to adequately address areas related to the requisite license/background checks. Additionally, the applicant also failed to provide the requested evidence of insurance due diligence, equipment ownership, and financial fitness.

For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED

APPEAL RIGHTS

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street,

Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.
