Mr. Homsher,

This is the comment you required explaining that RPM Trucking is still in business even though we posted a loss in our taxes.

RPM Trucking is an LLC, and we file our personal taxes in combination with our business taxes. Our expenses have been such that depreciation and other deductions have created a 'paper' loss. It has not been a lack of operations that has resulted in this 'zero revenue'. High operating costs (ie, high fuel prices, high tire prices, etc) and rates that have not increased in years have put small businesses like ours on a very narrow profit margin.

We are still very much in business and have been in continuous operation since we formed, including during COVID.

I must ask, with all the reporting we are required to do, why the PUC chose to look at our taxes to decide if we are still in business? Why not look at IFTA? Or if we have vehicles registered?

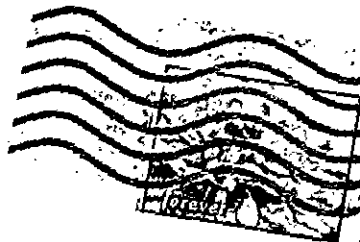
