Re: Application for the Abandonment of Electric Generation Supplier License for URA Inc.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

On April 8, 2026, URA Inc. A/K/A Utility Rates Analysts d/b/a School District Energy of Pennsylvania (URA) filed an application to abandon its Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) license as a broker/marketer in Pennsylvania. URA was initially licensed on August 2, 2012, under the name URA Inc., authorizing it to serve small commercial (25 kW and under), large commercial (over 25 kW), industrial and governmental customers in all of the electric distribution company service territories throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. On October 28, 2015, the company was approved to change its name to URA, Inc. A/K/A Utility Rates Analysts d/b/a School District Energy of Pennsylvania.

There are no outstanding fines pending against URA. There are also no outstanding formal or informal complaints and URA does not serve any customers.


Based on the foregoing, the notification provisions under 52 PA Code Section 54.41(b) are waived, as are the notification provisions in the Interim Guidelines Regarding Notification by an EGS of Operational Changes Affecting Customer Service and Contracts, at Docket No. M-00960890F0013.

We believe that the relinquishment and abandonment of URA's license will have no impact on the public, EDCs, or default service providers. Therefore, the Commission approves, by this Secretarial Letter, URA's application to abandon its EGS License at Docket No. A-2012-2303321 and its license is cancelled.

The Secretary's Bureau shall remove the company's name from all active utility lists maintained by the Commission. The Bureau of Administrative Services shall remove the company from all assessment lists. Additionally, if there are no outstanding claims against URA's financial security sixty (60) days after the service date of this letter, the Secretary's Bureau shall return URA's financial security instrument.
