### Conneaut Lake Park Water Corporation, Inc. Metering Program Compliance Report at Docket No. A-2022-3031711

- A-1. Ordering Paragraph 7 of the Commission's Order entered April 20, 2023, at Docket Nos. A-2022-3031711 and A-2022-3031712 (April 2023 Order) directed Conneaut to provide supporting data that addresses the numbers and sizes of water meters. Also, Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report, Page 3 specified that there are 152 service accounts that will need 152 meters and that the size of the meters required for these accounts will likely be a 3/4-inch meter. Please provide a breakdown of the number of metered customers that are served by Conneaut, by customer class and by meter size.
- A-2. Please provide a breakdown of the number of unmetered customers that are served by Conneaut, by customer class.
- A-3. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 65.8(e), a public utility shall provide and maintain suitable and adequate facilities for testing its meters or may have its meters certified by a standardizing laboratory. Please indicate whether Conneaut intends to acquire/construct and maintain the required meter testing facilities or have its meters certified by a standardizing laboratory.
- A-4. Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report does not appear to include information required by 52 Pa. Code § 5.591. Please provide a verification statement that confirms that Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report satisfies compliance with Ordering Paragraph 7 of the April 2023 Order.
- A-5. Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report did not include a signed verification statement from an authorized officer or employee indicating that the information provided in Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report is true and correct. Please provide a verification statement that references Conneaut's Metering Program Compliance Report filed with the Commission, and that complies with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36(b).
