REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted pro hac vice. Only an attorney may represent someone else. Attorneys must enter her/his appearance in accordance with Commission regulations before the scheduled hearing.

FAILURE TO APPEAR. Please arrive by 9:45 A.M. for your scheduled hearing. You may lose the case if you do not take part in this hearing and present evidence on the issue(s) raised.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause.

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov and send one (1) copy to the other party. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing. Pre-mark proposed exhibits for identification purposes.

ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability or an interpreter in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the OALJ scheduling office at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request. Persons who are speech or hearing-impaired may call a relay operator at 711.
