- 2. REPRESENTATION.** If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney representing you. **All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*.** 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21, 1.22. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else.

3. **FAILURE TO APPEAR.** You must attend the hearing and present evidence on the issues raised in the pleadings. Plan to arrive at the hearing no later than 9:45 AM.

4. **CONTINUANCES.** You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. Continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a motion at least five (5) days before the hearing and served pursuant to paragraph 5B below.

5. **PRESENTING EXHIBITS.** If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov and one (1) copy each must be sent to the other party. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing. Pre-mark proposed exhibits for identification purposes. **It is the parties' responsibility to redact any PII contained within a document or exhibit before submitting it into the record.** Do not file your proposed documents or exhibits with the Secretary's Bureau; however, you must file a Certificate of Service with the Secretary's Bureau indicating the manner in which you sent the proposed documents or exhibits to the other party.

6. **FILING AND SERVING DOCUMENTS.** When you file a document, you must provide the original to the Commission and serve a copy to the other party by e-Service or email, if the other party has agreed to electronic service. You must also serve the Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov. For your convenience, a copy of the Commission's current service list of all parties to this proceeding is enclosed with this Order.

7. **CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL.** If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing should be submitted by overnight delivery to ensure arrival. Filings containing confidential or proprietary material may also be submitted through the Commission's Share Point File system. These filings should be followed by a hard copy the Commission's file. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to set up a Share Point File before submitting the filing.

8. **CONTACT INFORMATION.** If your email address or telephone number changes

during the course of the proceeding, you must immediately update the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717.787.1399.

9. ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability or an interpreter in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the scheduling office of the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717.787.1399, at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

10. SETTLEMENT. The Commission’s policy is to encourage settlements. 52 Pa. Code § 5.231(a). The Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement shall contact the Respondent at least one week before the scheduled hearing to talk over a possible settlement of this case.

11. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. The parties shall be prepared to discuss the factors set forth at Section 182.10(2)(i)-(vi) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 182.10(2)(i)-(vi).

12. HEARING PROCEDURES. This is a formal hearing and will be conducted in accordance with the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure at 52 Pa. Code Chapters 1, 3, and 5.
