Dear Secretary:

On behalf of Professional Transportation Inc. I respectfully submit this formal comment in response to the Tentative Order regarding the cancellation of our Certificate of Public Convenience.

We understand that the Tentative Order proposes cancellation due to an alleged failure to report positive operating revenue. However, we respectfully request that the Commission reconsider this action based on the nature of our operations and ongoing contractual obligations.

Professional Transportation Inc. is currently contracted by a national railroad to provide crew transportation services. While we do not presently maintain a physical branch location within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, our operations are inherently interstate and demand based. We may be called upon at any time to begin transporting railroad employees within Pennsylvania as part of this existing contractual relationship.

As such, maintaining our CPC authority in Pennsylvania is essential to ensuring uninterrupted service to our client and supporting critical transportation infrastructure. Cancellation of our authority could impair our ability to respond promptly to operational needs and could negatively impact railroad operations within the Commonwealth.


Additionally, any lack of reported Pennsylvania operating revenue during the relevant reporting period does not reflect an abandonment of service or intent to cease operations, but rather the variable and contingent nature of our contractual work. We remain ready, willing, and able to provide service in Pennsylvania immediately upon request.

Considering the foregoing, we respectfully request that the Commission:

- Refrain from canceling our Certificate of Public Convenience; and
- Allow us to remain in good standing, subject to any compliance measures the Commission deems appropriate.

We are committed to full compliance with all applicable reporting requirements moving forward and are prepared to submit any additional documentation the Commission may require.
