FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero dated April 16, 2026, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Formal Complaint of Ayesha Mosley in Ayesha Mosley v. Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket No. F-2025-3057665 is granted.

2. That within thirty (30) days of the entry of a final Commission Order in this matter, Philadelphia Gas Works shall issue a bill to Ayesha Mosley in the amount of one-sixth (1/6th) of the balance accrued on her account.

3. That upon receipt of payment of one-sixth (1/6th) of the balance accrued on Ayesha Mosley's account, plus any other fees Philadelphia Gas Works may legally access, Philadelphia Gas Works shall reinstate service at the Service Address.

4. That beginning with the first billing due date following reinstatement of service, Ayesha Mosley shall make monthly payments consisting of her budget bill plus one-sixth (1/6th) of the balance accrued on her account, continuing thereafter on the due date for the payment of each regular monthly bill, until the arrearage on her account has been paid in full.

5. That, as long as Ayesha Mosley adheres to the terms of this Order, Philadelphia Gas Works shall not assess any late payment charges nor shall Philadelphia Gas Works terminate service to Ayesha Mosley, except for valid safety and/or emergency reasons.

6. That if Ayesha Mosley fails to keep the payment schedule, Philadelphia Gas Works is authorized to suspend or terminate her utility service in accordance with the Commission's statute and regulations.

7. That the Secretary's Bureau mark this matter closed.
