Our wooded land is a heavily populated area for bats, due to the local caverns. We also support the bats by providing bat houses for safety while they roost. We do not need to sacrifice our beautiful home and land for data centers, especially for another ₂ state that has chosen to shutdown their power plants.

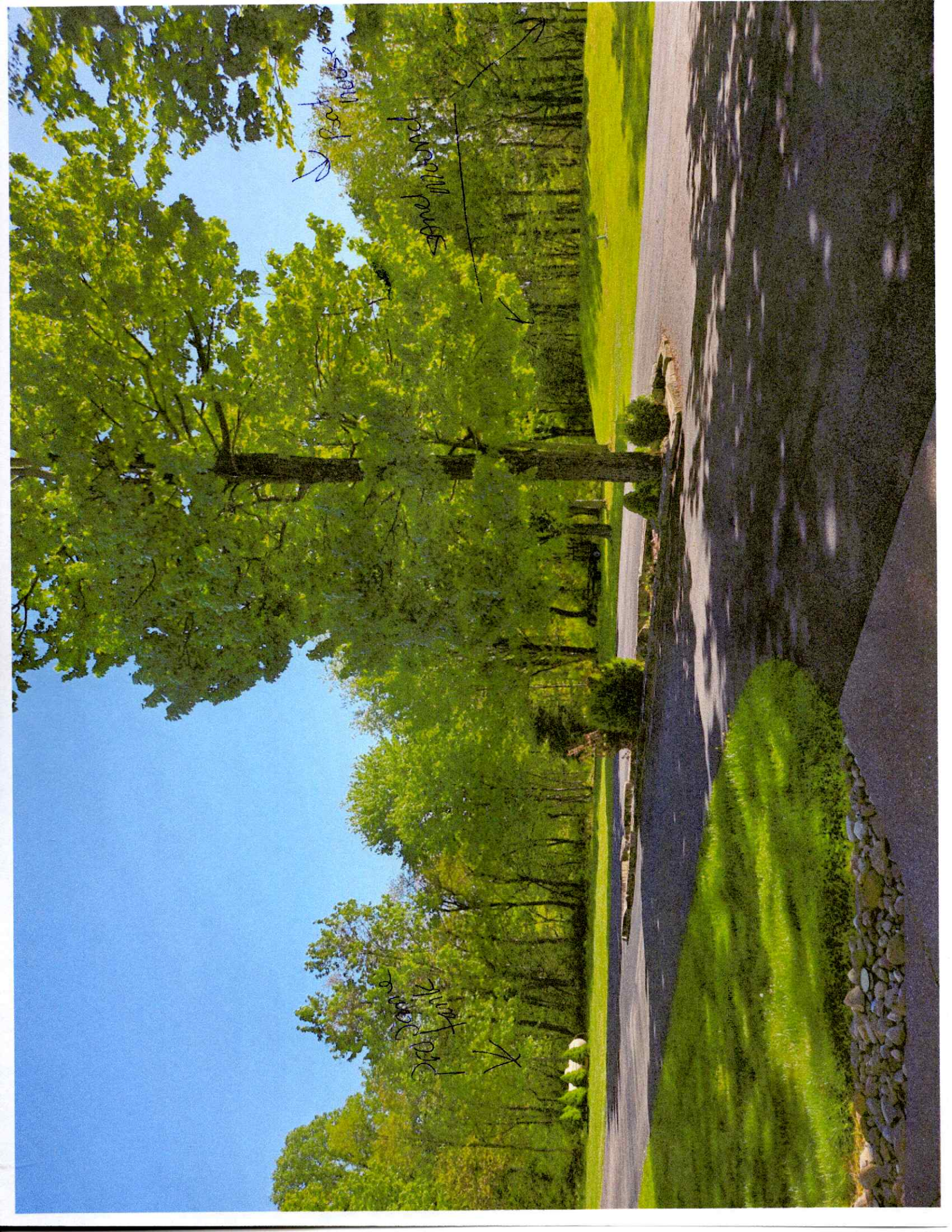
