

Request for Information

- 1.) Shoreshuttlepgh.com provided some clarification regarding your operations, but it appears that your services are currently being offered, prior to having PUC Authority, which is not allowed.
- 2.) Please clarify exactly what services are provided:
 - a) Is there a set route for the shuttle?
 - b) Is there a set schedule?
 - c) How do special events factor into your business model?
 - d) Under what circumstances are other customized services reserved?
 - e) How are charges made? Do charges vary by service? Explain fully.
- 3.) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements, particularly in regard to the frequency and retention of driver records – specific answers to these questions ARE REQUIRED, even if one of the owners will be a driver. These answers can easily be found by reading Title 52.** Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions.
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.
