1. On what date did the company cease all marketing activities? Please also confirm that the company will not engage in any marketing activities while the abandonment request is under review.

ENGIE Power & Gas (“EPG”) ceased marketing to new commercial customers in August 2025. EPG did not serve residential customers.

Customers under active transactions in August 2025 were assigned to New Wave Energy LLC as authorized by the terms of the service agreement between EPG and its commercial customers. The Public Utility Commission was notified of this transition in a letter dated August 19, 2025, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit A**. EPG ceased all retail natural gas and electricity business activity in Pennsylvania by the end of 2025.

2. Please provide proof of notice to the customers. Per 52 PA Code § 62.112 such notice must occur 90 and 60 days preceding the effective date of abandonment.

A copy of the form of notice used to inform customers of the assignment of gas service from EPG to New Wave Energy is included in the materials in **Exhibit A**. Assignment was completed last fall – EPG ceased serving gas customers prior to the end of 2025 and is now, with no gas customers, abandoning its license as part of winding down operations.

Dear Secretary Homsher:

I am writing to inform you that ENGIE Power & Gas LLC ("EPG") intends to assign approximately 447 small business, large business, and industrial Pennsylvania retail gas sales contracts to New Wave Energy, LLC ("New Wave") pursuant to a purchase agreement by and among New Wave, NextEra Energy Services Midwest, LLC, and EPG. The assigned sales contracts expressly authorize such assignment.

New Wave is a licensed competitive retailer and has extensive experience in the retail gas space. New Wave will continue to honor the contracts. There will be no change in price or any other term of service. One customer will remain with EPG following the transfer. EPG does not intend to abandon its license at this time.

Transfer of these contracts to New Wave is expected to occur on the first meter read date that is at least thirty days after the date customers are provided notice of the transfer. We are working diligently to ensure that customers and distribution utilities are properly informed and that no disruption of service occurs.

In accordance with the provisions of the Public Utility Commission's Customer Transfer Filing Checklist applicable to gas suppliers, Attachment A to this letter provides a copy of the customer notice that will be sent to all impacted customers within Pennsylvania. The notice conforms with the Commission's customer notice requirements. Customers will be able to receive answers to any outstanding questions via phone or email at the numbers and email addresses listed on the attached letter. Attachment B to this letter provides a signed Certificate of Service, which shall constitute proof of service on the five statutory agencies and all utilities in whose service territories EPG is licensed to operate.



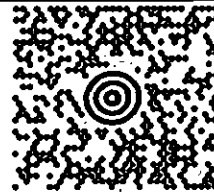

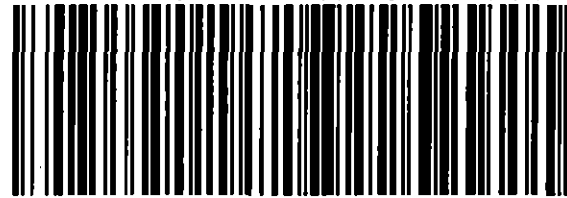
