a. In the past, ordinarily we find that it affects the public citizens yes, sir.

10. Your feeling is that the Illinois Service Commission is not interested at this time in view of the fact that there has been

animosity between the various organizations and municipalities that would have to bear the expense of this bridge ?

.. As far as bearing the expense goes, that is between Montgomery County and the City of Philadelphia, and we are in accord. The plans have been approved by both.

7. As to the deviation of this bridge and the clearance, have the regulations of the Public Service Commission with regard to matters of that character been considered ?

6. Yes, but we cannot live up to the standard in this particular case. We will do our best to recall and submitted the matter to the interested parties.

8. That could well be submitted so that the Public Service Commission will have an opportunity to see it ?

9. That is submitted on the plan.
