Abbreviated Securities Certificate of Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. to issue securities in the form of a Promissory Note to the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PENNVEST) in an amount no greater than \$3,600,000 to finance the replacement of lead and galvanized water service lines at customer properties located in Upper Darby Township, East Lansdowne Borough, Lansdowne Borough, Millbourne Borough, and Yeadon Borough in Delaware County, Pennsylvania.¹
