TO THE STATE REGULATORY AGENCY AND ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

The Complainant / Trustee, James Samuel Defoggi, hereby issues formal notice to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) and the Respondent, Duquesne Light Company, maintaining the integrity of the active administrative record and outlining the parameters of the ongoing ledger dispute.

STATEMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE FACTS:

1. A Formal Complaint docket remains actively open and served upon the Respondent, establishing a strict, mandatory automatic stay on all termination, collection, and extrajudicial enforcement actions regarding the subject account balance pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 1410 and 52 Pa. Code § 56.141.
2. On the public record, Complainant filed a formal *Notice of Judicial Recognition of Fiduciary Capacity*, establishing standing as the lawful Trustee for the private estate and moving the account out of standard consumer parameters.
3. Complainant explicitly notes for the record that the entire underlying account ledger and accounting method are actively being challenged under the Complainant's fiduciary capacity.
4. Consequently, Respondent is notified that there is no "undisputed amount" or "current balance" available for standard consumer collection scripts. Every aspect of the account accounting method remains an active matter of dispute until the Respondent formally rebuts the administrative notices and establishes a lawful ledger on the record before the Administrative Law Judge.
5. Any attempt by Respondent or its automated billing systems to issue termination threats or divide the ledger into "current balances" during this active proceeding will be treated as bad-faith extrajudicial coercion and direct contempt of the Commission's automatic stay rules.

NOTICE OF DEMAND: Respondent is commanded to ensure that all automated or manual collection scripts, termination flags, and account alterations remain completely suppressed while

this docket remains open. Respondent is required to maintain the status quo and address the accounting dispute exclusively through the formal administrative process.


