The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 415 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 and the supporting rate computations submitted on May 1, 2026 to become effective on June 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Generation Supply Charge-1 (GSC-1) rates, which include Time of Use (TOU) rates, for the six-month period of June 1, 2026 through November 30, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The GSC-1 is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
