Dear Ms. Klock:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Generation Supply Charge-2 (GSC-2) rate computations submitted on May 1, 2026 to become effective on June 1, 2026. No tariff was filed because the GSC-2 rate is not specified in the tariff rider.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed GSC-2 rate for the twelve-month period of June 1, 2026 through May 31, 2027, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The GSC-2 is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
