Good day Mr. Homsher I hope all is well. I am writing today in regards to a letter received about canceling our PUC certificate due to lack of operation in your jurisdiction.

We understand that the state of Pennsylvania has operation requirements to keep our PUC number and I am asking if there is any way you can keep our PUC # A-8913952 active. We have been faced with devastating circumstances with our five-year-old whom is battling cancer and we have not been able to operate our trucking business much in the past 2 years. My husband and I worked very hard to get this PUC number years ago and with the business operating with just the two of us it's been hard to keep the trucks moving with the circumstances at hand. Please note we live very close to the PA border and have traveled into PA with our trucks with in these past 2 years but not picking up within PA and Dropping off in PA which is the reporting requirements for revenue. If this is not correct please correct me as this is what we were told. Our Hope is that we can pick back up on our normal hauling when our daughters treatments ease up in the end of 2027.

We greatly appreciate your time and understanding in this matter and hope you will grant us to keep our PUC number.
