Request for Information

- 1.) Question #6 of the application. Please clarify your address, as the suite # was missing from this application.

- 2.) Question #9 of the application. The USDOT # provided is assigned to a different entity, "Peachey's Transportation Services LLC".
 - A.) Why is this information different from what is filed with the PUC?

 - B.) Remove this DOT number from this application as this is a different entity.

- 3.) Question #10 of the application. The Territory description is not acceptable. Please revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend. Please make corrections with the Commission's criteria in mind or verify that the example below is what you now intend.

Example:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Paratransit Service, from points in the Centre, Huntington, Juniata, Mifflin, and Snyder counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

- Please reference the attached list of territory/service templates on the last pages of this data request for guidance.

4.) Question #3 Verified Statement. The description of your transportation experience was vague; can you please provide the PUC, and/or US DOT #s, correlating name(s), dates, and duties.

5.) Question #4 Verified Statement.

A. Please respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

B. Please include an explanation of your plan to safeguard sensitive documents.

6.) Question #5 Verified Statement. Provide compliant driver hiring and employment policies for 52 Pa code § 29.506 Alcohol prohibition and § 29.507 Controlled substance prohibition. Who will be conducting drug/alcohol tests? How long will a driver have to wait after using alcohol and/or substances, which would affect driving before the driver will be permitted to drive?

7.) Question #6 Verified Statement. Provide a copy of the registrations/or titles in the name of the applicant (**Peachey's Transport Services LLC**) showing ownership of each vehicle listed.

8.) Question #8 Verified Statement. Have you made sure a Form E can be provided to PUC with the policy you referred to, with the name of Peachey's Transport Services LLC, nothing else will be accepted.

9.) The Verified Statement must be signed and dated.

10.) Financial position.

Make sure the assets and debts are held by the applicant **PEACHEY'S TRANSPORT SERVICES LLC** and not a separate entity or individual member.

A.) Explain what does the \$80,000 liability amount mean? To be clear this amount is due within one year?

B.) Provide a copy of a bank statement (with account number redacted), or an official letter from a bank officer, verifying the account holdings for **PEACHEY'S TRANSPORT SERVICES LLC**. The statement or letter should also demonstrate the balance date.

The bank statement provided did not identify the account holder. Without this information it is impossible to properly analyze **PEACHEY'S TRANSPORT SERVICES LLC** financial position. Should this requested proof not be submitted with your answers, this application must be denied and dismissed. If the applicant was previously unfunded, then now is the time for the applicant's accounts to be filled. Any assets which need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

C.) Ensure the math works. If you are unsure how to prepare a balance sheet you should consult an accounting professional prior to submitting. Provide an acceptable balance sheet.

D.) Give explanations for any changes to the balance sheet.

Note: If you are having trouble with your reply, you are encouraged to consult with an attorney familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings. It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards.

PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:

The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties.

Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.

Examples below:

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited to a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and
b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose

personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
