Good afternoon Ms. Tate,

On March 26, 2026, a prehearing conference was held, via telephone, in the above captioned matter. During the conference, I reiterated my ruling from my January 21, 2026 Order on PGW's Preliminary Objections. More specifically, I explained that the Commission lacks authority to remove municipal liens placed on a property by the City of Philadelphia due to a customer's outstanding balance with Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW).

Next, I addressed the true purpose of the conference, which was to provide you with information regarding PGW's Landlord Cooperation Program. PGW's attorney, Graciela

Christlieb, provided this information to you and you indicated, on the record, that your inquiry was satisfied.

Lastly, I provided you with instructions for submitting a written request to withdraw the present complaint with the Commission. You were instructed to do the following:

- 1) Explain that Barbara Arrington had passed away.
- 2) Explain that you wish to withdraw the present complaint because you received the information you requested.

You were provided with my office number and email address, as well as with a few days to submit your written request to withdraw the present complaint.

As of today, I have not received any communication from you.

Please submit via email your written request to withdraw the present complaint by close of business day on Friday, May 22, 2026.

If I do not receive your written request to withdraw the present complaint by close of business day on Friday, May 22, 2026, I shall issue a decision closing the case based on your oral averment at the conference that you were satisfied with the Company's information and explanation.
