To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3062228 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

On May 5, 2026, the applicant was issued a 10-day data request in response to its application for authority. The applicant's two-part responses were received on May 26, 2026. A complete review of the applicant's initial application and its subsequent responses has determined that the applicant has failed to demonstrate its ability to offer safe, efficient and reasonable transportation.

In its submissions, the applicant has omitted evidence of hiring/retention policies which satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code §§ 29.503-29.505. Additionally, the applicant has failed to provide full disclosure on the crime for which the sole member remains under Federal supervision. This omission prevents the Commission from determining the applicant's sole member's suitability for control of the authority. Finally, the financial evidence provided by the applicant lists only the applicant's sole member's name on the account. This alone does not establish that the funds belong to the applying entity.

**For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED**

**APPEAL RIGHTS**

**ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.**

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.
