Dear Ms. Savage:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company's proposed Supplement No. 36 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 and the supporting rate computations submitted on April 17, 2026 to become effective on June 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Price to Compare Default Service Rider and Hourly Pricing Default Service Rider (PTC/HPDSR) rates for the six-month period of June 1, 2026 through November 30, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The PTC/HPDSR rates are subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2026-3061875.
