

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Note: Please restate the data request prior to providing a response. In addition, provide the name and title of the person(s) providing the response and/or information for each data request.

A-18. In the responses to Data Requests A-1 and A-10, PAWC-WD provided a copy of a revised requested territory map (Revised Requested Territory Map) that appears to include two additional parcels along Strasburg Road and Wilmington Road and portions of approximately 15 parcels situated along the east side of Doe Run Road (collectively Additional Parcels). However, the Application’s DEP Planning Module Approval Letter dated June 17, 2025, limits the provision of wastewater service to only the new Doe Run Elementary School (New Elementary School). Please provide responses to the following:

- a. Provide evidence of DEP approval of the additional sewage facilities planning required to extend wastewater service to the Additional Parcels included in the revised Requested Territory Maps along with copies of any approval letters from DEP and associated conditions; or
- b. Provide revised confidential and public maps for an amended Requested Territory that remove the Additional Parcels and contains only the limits of the New Elementary School parcel and the public rights-of-way needed for construction of the Main Extension and include a boundary description with bearing angles and distances along with a quantification of the revised Requested Territory area in acres.

A-19. In response to Data Request A-6 (Data Request A-6 Response), PAWC-WD indicated that the Main Extension will include both ten-inch and eight-inch diameter gravity mains and a four-inch diameter force main as depicted in Attachment A-5.1 in the response to Data Request A-5. Conversely, the updated Engineering Report (Updated Engineering Report) included as Attachment A-8 in response to Data Request A-8 described that the Main Extension will include only an eight-inch diameter gravity main and a two-inch diameter force main. Further, the Updated Engineering Report did not include a quantification for the number of manholes included with the Main Extension, a breakdown of the major components of the Pump Station including the number, type and capacity of the pumps, and the projected schedule for installation of the Main Extension and, separately, for the Pump Station pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.514(a)(3)(i). Please provide responses to the following:

- a. Clarify the apparent discrepancy for the pipeline facilities included in the Main Extension between the Data Request A-6 Response that included both ten-inch and eight-inch diameter gravity mains along with a four-inch diameter force main and the Updated Engineering Report that included only an eight-inch diameter gravity main and a two-inch diameter force main;
- b. Quantify the number of manholes included as part of the Main Extension;

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- c. Provide a breakdown of the major components of the Pump Station including the number, type, and capacity of the pumps;
- d. Provide a projected schedule for installation of the Main Extension and, separately, for the Pump Station; and
- e. Provide a revised Engineering Report prepared and stamped by a professional engineer licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that includes the responses to Data Requests A-18.a. through A-18.d.
