The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed Supplement No. 102 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 and the supporting rate computations submitted April 1, 2026 to become effective June 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Default Service Supply (DSS) rates, for Residential & Lighting and Small Commercial & Industrial classes for the six-month period of June 1, 2026 through November 30, 2026; and for the Medium Commercial & Industrial class for the three-month period of June 1, 2026 through August 31, 2026, are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSS is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
