
Dear Parties:

On January 14, 2026, the Commission entered an Initial Decision in the above-referenced matter. Numerous parties have filed exceptions and reply exceptions to the Initial Decision. Because exceptions and reply exceptions have been filed, this matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On May 4, 2026, the Commission received a letter from State Senator Kristin Phillips-Hill. Senator Phillips-Hill's letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Stephen DeFrank. Senator Phillips-Hill's letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues litigated in the above-referenced case.

Because the subject matter of Senator Phillips-Hill's letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, Senator Phillips-Hill's letter constitutes an *ex parte* communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the *ex parte* communication, I am placing Senator Phillips-Hill's Letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and Senator Phillips-Hill's letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
