1. Please provide a letter of "tax status" or "tax clearance certificate" (REV-181) from the PA Dept. of Revenue.

ENGIE Power & Gas ("EPG") cannot provide this material from the DOR at this time as EPG has not yet finalized its tax filings in the state of Pennsylvania. This material will have to be submitted in a supplemental response, which EPG will submit no later than December 15, 2026.

2. Please summarize any outstanding tax issues you have with the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue.

There are no outstanding tax issues at this time, but tax filings have not yet been made for 2025.

3. On what date did the company cease all marketing activities? Please also confirm that the company will not engage in any marketing activities while the abandonment request is under review.

EPG ceased marketing electricity supply service to new commercial customers in August 2025. EPG did not serve residential customers. Most customer contracts were assigned by EPG to its affiliate ENGIE Resources LLC, a retailer of electricity supply that remains active in Pennsylvania. The transactions that were not assigned expired before the end of 2025 and those customers were returned by EPG to default provider service. EPG ceased all business activity in Pennsylvania prior to the end of 2025.

4. Please ensure that the company is up to date with submitting its quarterly gross receipts and retail sales report, even if the company has zero sales to report.

EPG's most recent gross receipts quarterly filing was made in Q3 of 2025. EPG will submit a Q4 2025 gross receipts report and a zero sales filing for Q1 2026 prior to May 31, 2026.

5. Please explain any open issues regarding contracts, agreements or other arrangements which you may have with any party under your license, that affects or may affect the flow of electricity generation at retail. Provide a summary of each issue and its current status. Provide copies of all contracts, agreements or other arrangements that are involved.

No open issues exist; all customer activity wound down in 2025.

6. Please provide proof of service upon each of the Electric Distribution Companies with whom the licensee is authorized to operate.

No notice of EPG's decision to withdraw from the electricity market in Pennsylvania was made to the Electric Distribution Companies because EPG ceased serving customers in those service territories well ahead of submitting its request to surrender the license. That said, EPG notified the EDCs of the cessation of business activity earlier this year and is currently actively working through the process to wind-down operations with each EDC.
