Re: Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission v. Energy Center Harrisburg LLC

Dear Attorney Lesser:

By Order entered March 12, 2026, the Commission authorized Energy Center Harrisburg LLC (the Company) to file a tariff supplement containing revised rates, rules, and regulations, as shown in Appendix A to the Settlement in the above-docketed rate investigation. The revised rates are designed to produce \$894,300 in additional annual distribution base rate operating revenue, with an exception for residential customers, given their unique position on the Company's steam distribution system, whose rates are designed using an assumed annual increase in distribution base rate operating revenue of only \$720,000. On May 27, 2026, the Company filed Supplement No. 69 to Steam – Pa. P.U.C No. 4, to become effective for service rendered on and after May 28, 2026, pursuant to the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplement is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
