

To Parties of Record:

On May 20, 2026, Luis Francisco (Petitioner) filed a petition seeking reconsideration of an Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judges DeVoe and Quimby on May 5, 2026, which denied the Petitioner's request to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. Upon review of the Petitioner's filing, it appeared that the Petitioner: (1) failed to serve his filing on the parties of record; and (2) failed to include a Certificate of Service in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.54. In order to ensure due process and correct the Petitioner's failure to serve his filing on the parties of record, on May 22, 2026, the Commission placed a Secretarial Letter on the record of the docket and served it electronically on the parties of record, along with a copy of the Petitioner's filing.

Upon further review of the Petitioner's filing, and in order to provide clarity to and protect the due process rights of all parties, the Commission, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.2, shall deem the filing to be a Petition for Interlocutory Review (Petition) subject to the Commission's Regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.301, et seq. Accordingly, interested parties may submit a brief supporting or opposing the Petition as soon as possible, but no later than ten days of service of this Secretarial Letter (i.e., June 8, 2026). 52 Pa. Code § 5.302(b). All filings to the docket must be served by the submitting party on all other parties of record pursuant to the Commission's procedural rules at 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.51-1.59. Additional briefs will not be permitted. 52 Pa. Code § 5.302(d). The Commission will act promptly on the Petition consistent with 52 Pa. Code § 5.303.
