



**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PECO ENERGY COMPANY  
FOR A CONTINUANCE OF THE SCHEDULED HEARING**

PECO Energy Company (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Marta Guhl (Judge Guhl) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing for Wednesday, June 10, 2026 (Hearing) as undersigning counsel has a scheduled conflict at the same date and time.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On or about March 19, 2026, Jeffrey Saperstein (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint alleging that he was unaware that he was enrolled with an electric generation supplier (EGS) for service in his name to 307 Headley Street, Apt. 2, Bristol, Pennsylvania (Service Address) under Account No. 7342651222 (Account).

2. On April 8, 2025, the Company filed an Answer averring that, at all times relevant to this proceeding, its actions have been performed in accordance with all applicable laws, as well as PECO's Commission-approved tariff, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code (Code), Commission regulations and orders. PECO specifically denies that it has any control over the rates

charged by an EGS. As a result, PECO is unable to determine if the Complainant was correctly billed for the EGS service.

3. By Notice, dated April 15, 2026, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Wednesday, June 10, 2026, before Judge Guhl.

4. Undersigning counsel has a previously scheduled conflict with the current Wednesday, June 10, 2026, hearing date, in a separate, unrelated matter.

5. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.


6. The unavailability of undersigning counsel constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

7. On June 1, 2026, the undersigning counsel contacted the Complainant to notify him of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing. The Complainant advised that he does not oppose the Company's continuance request.

8. The Company respectfully requests the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after Wednesday, June 10, 2026.

**WHEREFORE**, for good cause shown, PECO Energy Company requests that the Honorable Marta Guhl grant its Motion for Continuance of the scheduled Wednesday, June 10, 2026, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
