Small Non-Residential	0 to 120,450 kWh annual usage (25 kW * 55% load factor * 8760 hours in the year)
Medium Non-Residential	120,451 to 2,409,000 kWh annual usage (500kW * 55% load factor * 8760 hours in the year)
Large Non-Residential	2,409,001 kWh annual usage and greater
