

Note: Due to the anticipated overlapping of issues and parties, a prehearing conference is being scheduled in this matter contemporaneously with the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC filed Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57, Subchapter G, for Approval of the Siting and Construction of the 230 kV Transmission Line Known as Project 9A West in a Portion of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at Docket No. A-2026-3062686 and the Petition of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for Confirmation of an Exemption from Local Zoning Regulation and for the Construction of Buildings in Connection with the Construction of a Proposed Electric Substation in Greene Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at Docket No. P-2026-3062687. However, these proceedings have not yet been formally consolidated. Issues related to and the potential for consolidation will be discussed at the Prehearing Conference.

Individuals representing themselves are not required to be represented by an attorney at the prehearing conference. All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must

be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted pro hac vice. An attorney representing you should file a Notice of Appearance before the scheduled prehearing conference date.
