Re: Application of *Attentive Medical Transportation LLC* for Paratransit authority, 801 Grant Road, Folcroft, Delaware County, Pennsylvania 19032. (610) 579-1006.

To whom it may concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application for Paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2026-3062930 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience shall not be granted for the following reasons:

On February 10, 2026, the Commission denied the applicant for Paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2026-3060284 due to insufficient financial resources, specifically a reported cash balance of \$1,000.

On June 3, 2026, a new Paratransit service authority application was accepted for review by the Commission. Upon examination of the information submitted, the Commission determined that the applicant failed to demonstrate the financial fitness necessary to provide safe, efficient, and reliable transportation service. The financial information submitted with the application again reflected a cash balance of \$1000. The Commission finds that the applicant's available liquidity has not improved and is still insufficient to support ongoing transportation operational expenses, such as commercial insurance premiums, vehicle maintenance, and regulatory compliance costs.

In addition, the applicant failed to adequately establish technical fitness. The submission contained substantial information that was not relevant to the Commission's fitness review and lacked policies necessary to demonstrate compliance with applicable Commission regulations.

It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial and technical ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. For this reason(s), your application is **DENIED** and **DISMISSED**. Please note: this denial does not prevent the applicant from submitting a new application in the future upon demonstrating compliance with applicable fitness requirements.

## APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

**ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by mail.**

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:
