BRIEFING ORDER

Evidentiary hearings were held in this matter on June 2 and 3, 2026. During the hearing, pre-served testimony and exhibits identified by UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania, and the Retail Energy Supply Association were admitted into the record. We also advised the parties that we would subsequently issue a briefing order, following the conclusion of the hearing.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Main Briefs of the parties are due on or before Tuesday, June 23, 2026;
2. That Main Briefs shall: be limited to 150 pages, not including Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, or Ordering Paragraphs; be written in Times New Roman or Calibri 12pt font; and, have 1” margins all around.
3. That Reply Briefs, or submission of a joint settlement petition executed by representatives of parties thereto, together with all parties’ statements in support of the joint petition/settlement, are due on or before Monday, July 6, 2026, by 12 p.m.;
4. That Reply Briefs shall: be limited to 85 pages, not including Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, or Ordering Paragraphs; be written in Times New Roman or Calibri 12pt font; and, have 1” margins all around.
5. That the Briefs must substantially comply with the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.501, 5.502;
6. That Main Briefs shall include as appendices: (a) proposed Findings of Fact, together with page references to statements of testimony and exhibits; (b) proposed Conclusions of Law, together with legal citations and (c) proposed Ordering Paragraphs;
7. That any full or partial settlement shall include proposed Findings of Fact, proposed Conclusions of Law, and proposed Ordering paragraphs;
8. That the statements in support filed alongside any full or partial settlement shall explain, in substantial detail, why approval of the settlement by the Commission is in the public interest.
9. That all parties must use a common outline for Main and Reply Briefs, as agreed upon by the parties.

10. That when filing Briefs, the parties shall also attach completed tables; to the extent that certain numbers have been modified since the initial filing has been made, all parties must use the same starting point when calculating tables and proposing adjustments so that all parties use the same reference points in the tables and briefs; therefore, prior to submitting briefs, the parties should agree to the base reference point for the tables submitted by all parties, including whether the tables should be identified as “as filed” or “modified” claims;

11. That if a party submits a Brief containing confidential information, the party must submit two versions of the brief: (1) one version conspicuously marked as containing confidential information, only to be served to the ALJs and those active parties that have executed Appendix A to the Protective Order issued in this proceeding; and (2) a second, public version with all confidential information redacted. When filing a brief containing confidential information, parties must clearly indicate to the Commission’s Secretary’s Bureau that the brief contains confidential information to ensure that the brief is not published on the Commission’s website, and to ensure that it is appropriately filed.

12. That the parties shall file the original copy of the Main Brief with the Commission no later than 4:30 p.m. on the date due;

13. That the parties shall file the original copy of the Reply Brief with the Commission no later than 12 p.m. on the date due;

14. That any brief not filed and served on or before the dates set forth above will not be accepted except by special permission;

15. That the parties are reminded that they are to e-mail us a copy of their as-filed briefs in a WORD-formatted document at fbrady@pa.gov and alphonarno@pa.gov; and

16. That the parties are advised not to include any extra-record evidence in their briefs.
