Adamski Excavating & Paving Inc

We have received notice of the tentative determination to cancel our company's Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) due to filing of annual assessment reports for at least two consecutive years that indicate zero jurisdictional total gross intrastate operating revenues for fiscal assessment purposes.

We are a small business excavating and paving company whose primary revenue comes from residential and small commercial excavating and paving projects. A PUC number was obtained for the purpose of being able to generate income via contract hauling for local quarry companies. Contract hauling was a very small part of our total jobs/income. There have been recent years where the amount of our own excavating and paving work did not allow for contract hauling for other companies.

Annual reports for **2023 And 2024** Reflected 0 adjusted income because we did not perform any contracted hauling work for those calendar years. 2025 Report did reflect generated income as we were able to contract our truck out for a few days to a local quarry.

To the best of our knowledge we have filed all of the required documents and maintained DQF files since obtaining the PUC number. Please advise as to whether Adamski Excavating & Paving Inc can continue to maintain PUC status.
