

Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

The territory/service description is not acceptable. The description needs to be clear and concise. Please make corrections with the Commission's criteria in mind or verify that below is what you now intend.

**Example:** *To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, restricted to non-emergency medical transportation, between points in the City and County of Philadelphia.*

2.) Question #3 Verification Statement.

A.) The description of transportation experience is vague. Please provide details of past transportation experience/training and with employers' names, dates of employment, and duties.

B.) Responses such as, "I will be completing an EMSVO PA training within the next thirty (30) days" are unacceptable as the application question is the request. Explain why this training is not completed as this same verification statement has been mentioned in application Docket # A-2025-3056662 signed on 8/3/2025 and

application Docket # A-2026-3060343 signed on 2/6/2026 by the sole member,  
Omar Montanez.

3.) Question #6 Verification Statement.

A.) Provide a description of the indicated company vehicle, which must include the  
Make, Model, Year, Vin and Milage.

B.) Include a copy of the vehicle registration and/or title for each vehicle currently in  
the possession of PA Care Transit Services LLC.

C.) If there is no company ownership of a vehicle, please provide an explanation as to  
why you believe your company is equipped to provide transportation services.

4.) Financial Position.

A.) The Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) was omitted with application  
submission. Please provide it for proper financial fitness evaluation.

B.) Also provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means  
of support include copies of bank statements (account numbers may be redacted),

or official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers with current contact information.

- At this point it is expected that the company is funded and ready to commence operations. Any assets which may need to be transferred to the applicant (**PA Care Transit Services LLC**) should happen prior to adding them to the required balance sheet. The Commission will need to determine that you have financial capabilities to run a safe, efficient, and reliable transportation operation. If you are unable to provide a compliant balance sheet with supporting information, your application will be denied, as per 52 Pa. Code §41.14. It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service.

NOTE: Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney and financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.
