

**MOTION TO EXCUSE LINDA S. KIZUKA FROM PERSONALLY
APPEARING AT THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING IN THIS MATTER**

In accordance with the provisions of 52 Pa. Code § 1.22 (out-of-state appearances), Pa. Bar Rule 301(a) (admission *pro hac vice*), Pa.R.C.P. 1012 (appearance), and the Prehearing Order issued in this proceeding, Linda S. Kizuka, Esq. hereby moves to be excused from personally appearing at the evidentiary hearing scheduled for June 15 and 16, 2026, as continued and until adjourned, in the above-captioned matter and states the following:

**INTERIM ORDER
GRANTING CONSTELLATION MOTION TO EXCUSE**

On June 5, 2026, Linda S. Kizuka, counsel for Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. and Constellation Energy Generation, LLC (collectively, “Constellation”), filed a motion to be excused from appearing at the evidentiary hearing scheduled for June 15 and 16, 2026, as continued and until adjourned.

By way of background, Colleen P. Kartychak sponsored and moved for the admission *pro hac vice* of attorneys Ms. Kizuka and Marsha D. Makel, Esq. to appear and participate on behalf of Constellation in this proceeding. That unopposed motion was granted by interim order entered on March 16, 2026. On March 26, 2026, Ms. Kartychak filed a motion to be excused from appearing in the proceedings in this matter until further notice so long as Ms. Kizuka and/or Ms. Makel will be in attendance. That unopposed motion was granted by the interim order entered on April 16, 2026. Ms. Kartychak remains as attorney of record for Constellation.

In support of the instant motion, Ms. Kizuka avers that she, Ms. Kartychak, and Ms. Makel are all employed by Constellation and work closely on matters within the legal department generally and specifically as to the instant matter. Ms. Kizuka states that it is intended that Ms. Makel will be lead counsel for Constellation for purposes of the evidentiary

The period for filing objections to the motion has passed, with no objections filed. As the requested relief is reasonable and unopposed, it will be granted with the conditions set forth in the ordering paragraphs below.
