Dear Merle Stoltzfus:

On January 30, 2025, Nantmeal Warwick Sewer Company, Inc. (Nantmeal) filed an affiliated interest agreement (January 2025 AIA) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 2102, *et seq.* By the Secretarial Letter dated January 31, 2025, the Commission extended the statutory consideration period for the January 2025 AIA until further action of the Commission. On May 18, 2026, Nantmeal filed a revised affiliated interest agreement (Revised AIA) with the Commission. By the Secretarial Letter dated May 19, 2026, the Commission extended the statutory consideration period for the Revised AIA until further action of the Commission.

Upon review of the filing, it does not appear that the Revised AIA is unreasonable or contrary to the public interest. Therefore, the filing is hereby approved. This approval applies only to the Revised AIA and services, matters, and parties specifically and clearly defined under this instant proceeding. However, approval of this filing does not constitute a determination that associated costs or expenses are reasonable or prudent for the purposes of determining just and reasonable rates. Furthermore, Commission approval is contingent upon the possibility that subsequent audits, reviews, and inquiries in any Commission proceeding may be conducted, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 2102, *et seq.*, and further investigation will occur in an appropriate rate proceeding.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration of staff action with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
