To Whom it May Concern:

On April 16, 2026, the Commission entered a Tentative Order, Docket No. M-2026-3061408, which advised HAGGERTY'S RIDES INC that it was not in compliance with the insurance requirements of 66 Pa.C.S. § 512. The Tentative Order advised HAGGERTY'S RIDES INC, that it must, within 30 days of publication of the Tentative Order, either have acceptable evidence of insurance filed with the Commission, cancel their authority, or file comments to the Tentative Order. The Tentative Order advised HAGGERTY'S RIDES INC that, if it failed to respond, its certificate of public convenience would be cancelled. The Tentative Order was served on HAGGERTY'S RIDES INC and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

HAGGERTY'S RIDES INC failed to respond to the April 16, 2026, Tentative Order and remains in non-compliance with the insurance requirements of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa.C.S. § 512.

Furthermore, this Commission will request the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to put an administrative hold on Respondent's vehicle registrations. Respondent will **NOT** be able to register any new vehicles or renew any existing vehicle registrations until a new application for authority is submitted. Additionally, all unpaid fines or assessments accrued while you had authority, are still due.

YOU ARE ADVISED: That the certificate(s) issued at Docket No. A-2016-2570266 & A-2017-2594363 & A-2017-2594373 be and is hereby *cancelled*, and all rights, powers, and privileges granted thereby shall forthwith cease and terminate.
