Respondent:

On January 21, 2026, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint at C- 2026-3059923 against Keystone Transportation LLC. Respondent, alleging that it permitted a vehicle to be operated that failed to display Respondent's name and associated PUC certificate of convenience number, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.71(a). The penalty for this violation is \$50.00. Additionally, the vehicle had an expired Pennsylvania inspection decal, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.405; 75 Pa. C.S. §4703(a). The penalty for this violation is \$250.00. Additionally, the vehicle had an inoperable parking brake, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.402(1); 67 Pa. Code §175.64(c). The penalty for this violation is \$50.00. The combined violations have a total penalty of \$350.00.

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified Respondent that it must file an Answer to the Complaint in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, within twenty days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondent failed to answer the Complaint within twenty days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request the Commission to issue a letter fining Respondent the sum of \$350.00.


The Complaint was sent by certified mail on March 3, 2026. The Complaint was served on March 3, 2026. To date, no response has been received from Respondent.

Respondent is assessed a fine of \$350.00 for failure to comply with the provisions of 66 Pa. Code. Payment must be made by certified check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of PA, and mailed to PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq.

If you disagree with this determination you may appeal to the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.44 or, if you believe that you have received this letter in error, you must write a letter stating the reasons you believe this letter is in error and requesting that it be rescinded within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The letter shall be sent to Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.
