 - b. Your system for conducting criminal background checks; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.505 – Criminal History)**
 - i. How often will you conduct criminal background checks? Please provide a compliant policy for the frequency of criminal history checks that complies with the regulation found at Title 52 Pa Code §29.505(a)(2).
 - ii. What type of things in their criminal background check would disqualify them from employment? Please provide a policy that complies with Title 52 Pa Code §29.505(a)(3) for what would disqualify a prospective driver based on what was discovered in their criminal history check.
