Dear Parties:


On April 24, 2026, Brightspeed of Pennsylvania, LLC (Brightspeed) filed a Letter Request for a 30-day extension until June 5, 2026, to file a response to Complainant's Formal Complaint. On the same date the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter granting the extension. In its original Letter Request, Brightspeed averred that it is actively engaged in investigating Complainant's claims and that the parties are working together to amicably resolve the Complainant's claims. Brightspeed also indicated that Complainant did not object to the extension.

On June 5, 2026, Brightspeed filed its second request for an extension to file a response to Complainant's Formal Complaint. In its second request, Brightspeed stated that the parties continue to work together to amicably address Complainant's claims and need additional time to effectuate a settlement resolution. Accordingly, Brightspeed now seeks an additional 60-extension until August 7, 2026, to file a responsive pleading to Complainant's Complaint. Complainant consents to the extension.

Brightspeed is granted an extension of time to file its responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint.

Brightspeed's Answer and any other responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on August 7, 2026.
